

PURITY CODE TRAINING & RING CEREMONY

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ'S)

1. **Do I have to go through the class to participate in the ceremony? YES!** We want this commitment to be between the student and God, with you and our church as witnesses to this commitment. The Purity Code Series study on every Saturday in March at 9:30 a.m. **will** give you tools to prepare for the commitment.

2. Is there a **registration fee?** **No. Registration is required and a copy of the book "The Purity Code" by Jim Burns will be provided upon registration.**

3. **Why do I have to register?** Registration will ensure that we have ample seating and food for you and your guest at the formal ceremony and reception. Each participant will be allowed to invite as many people as they would like to the ceremony, but only 6 guest per participant(not including participant will be allowed at the reception)

4. **How long and when do the classes begin?** Classes will begin the Saturday in March at 9:30 a.m. The Series is approximately 4 weeks.

5. **What if my student has already made this commitment, should they do it again?** Yes, I would encourage every student to make a recommitment to this area of their lives. The student is maturing, and being faced with new situations each year. Reaffirming this commitment is important to them. When reaffirming you can reuse the same ring given at the first commitment (yes, you can use the same clothes as well)

6. **What is the attire for the event?** Girls should be in all white formal/semi formal dresses with white shoes (shoes may be open toe but no sandals. Dresses must be an appropriate length for a sacred ceremony). Boys are to be dressed in white or cream tuxedos or suits with ties. Belts are required (no sagging). Parents may dress in Sunday best if desired.

7. **What type and where do I get the ring, pendant, or other item?** Walmart, WAITT(www.waitt.org), Lifeway Bookstore (off the internet or in store), Google *True Love Waits Jewelry* and you will find plenty of options at various pricing. You may also use a ring that has been passed down in your family!

8. **What if I cannot attend because of work, illness, or other reason?** Each student is required to bring a person of accountability with them to support them in this decision (a parent, guardian, close relative, coach or teacher). This person should be a mature adult in the student's life that will encourage a life of purity on a biblical basis. **ABSOLUTLEY NO GIRLFRIENDS OR BOYFRIENDS!!!**

9. **What if my student has already fallen in the area of sexual purity?** They can still make a commitment to purity, "from this point forward until they enter in a Biblical marriage relationship." God's redemptive power is greater than sin. I John 1:9, "if we confess our sin to God, He is faithful and just to forgive us of that sin and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."
